

## **An Announcement from Fr. O’Keeffe**

The casual observer will see the beginning of construction along 950 East, just north of the parish. Land has been purchased by developers for a neighborhood of homes for ‘active’ retired persons. The developers were efficient and kind to keep the parish leadership informed of the details as the planning progressed. They expect to have the new street and homes done in 18 months.

This may require a change in people’s daily routine of commuting or school pickup and drop-off; please slow down for construction traffic. This is likely to make some difference in RE, 4:twelve, and Antioch pickup and drop-off as well. There will be a rough road to travel on the weekends coming to Mass. As Zionsville continues to grow, the intersection of 950 East and Oak Street requires extra patience and caution. There are no plans on the community calendar to make changes to this intersection. There are no plans on the community calendar to repair 950 East after the construction finishes.

The parish will benefit by adding four acres immediately north of the church to our property line. The potential for improvements to the land will be shared throughout the coming Fruitful Harvest Campaign. As a parish, we are fortunate to have the opportunity to consider plans for the future as we look at anticipated growth of the community and of our spiritual home.
